These boxes are made of unpainted, untreated 3/4" - 1" wood or PVC, have an overhanging slanted roof (2-5", with a shallow saw kerf (groove) to keep rain from entering the box), no perch, a round 1.5" diameter hole (or 1.375" x

2.250" oval hole. Bluebirding Basics - nests and eggs, timetable, nestboxes ... - Quick tips: Buy mealworms online for the best price, train bluebirds to come to the feeder, and offer about 15 worms/bird/day in a glass/plastic dish 100 feet away from the nestbox inside a special feeder that excludes larger birds and protects worms from sun and rain.
